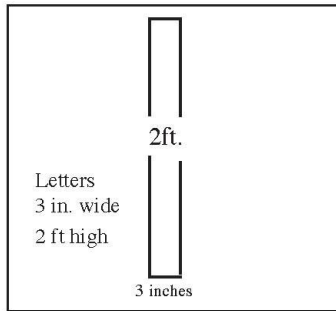

| SAILPAST ROUTE: | Tsehum Harbour to Sidney Docks then past Anacortes Ferry Dock towards Bazan Bay. Make tight turn around the auxiliary vessel anchored then a smooth, orderly run back and past the Sidney Docks again back to Tsehum Harbour or Port Sidney. | |
